Dear Chevre,

Please join me for services this Shabbat morning, sedra EMOR.

As usual, we will meet at the JCC and on Zoom, at 10 AM.

In sedra Emor, we read the following: "But I will be hallowed among the children of Israel!"

The Talmud infers from this verse that the prayer of Kedushah (during the repetition of the Amidah) can only be recited in the presence of a Minyan, a quorum of Ten! (Berachot,21b).

Sefer Chasidut derives from this a further spiritual insight.

No person can be concerned with his/her own self-purification.

"EIN HAYACHID OMER KEDUSHAH" (a single worshiper cannot recite Kedushah).

A Jew must always be concerned with the plight and general welfare of the whole Jewish people.

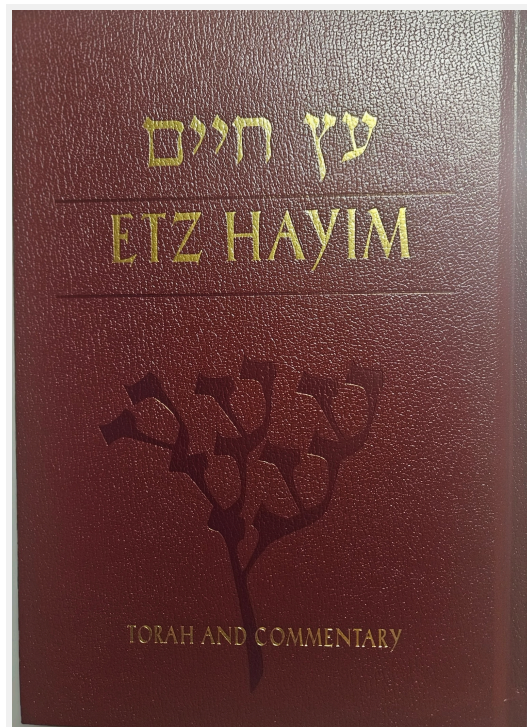
