"If I find in Sodom fifty righteous within the city..."

Avraham beseeches God to spare the wicked city, for the sake of the few righteous "within the city."

The question is asked: "Why does the text add the phrase 'within the city'?"

The words fifty righteous would be sufficient.

This answer provides some insight:
"It is a simple matter to discover
'righteous' people in the synagogue,
but can Avraham find righteous
people OUTSIDE the of the
synagogue - in the marketplace?
(Ibn Ezra).
