Lehavdil, the sedra Tetzave tells us:
"To cause a lamp to burn continually..."

In the Shule, the Eternal Light, symbolic of the eternal illumination radiating God, designates the place of the Ark, the repository of the Scrolls of the Torah!

The Ner Tamid, also symbolizes the indestructibility of the Jewish People.

Rashi interprets TAMID to mean "every single light."

From this we derive the lesson that whenever anyone voluntarily and sincerely performs a Mitzvah the illumination radiating from that good deed sheds light forever!

We ought seek to bring some rays of light into the darkness of other lives.
